Operational Red Flags for Narcotic Investigation This Class is Free

SYNOPSIS

This class will cover the warning signs officers must consider when planning and executing undercover narcotics operations, the signs that a suspect is planning to rip off law enforcement and the indicators of impending violence. This training will utilize scenario-based review of previous incidents to identify the indicators that should dictate an operation be paused or canceled to keep officers and informants safe. Integrating proper de-confliction protocols and introduction to operations such as buy walks, buy busts, flashes, surveillance, UC meetings and reverses will be covered. Officers will have a good general understanding of the primary indicators that a suspect might be planning an attack.

INSTRUCTOR

Epi Sevillo is a retired Special Agent Supervisor and Task Force Commander. He has 34 years of public service, 4 years in the United States Marine Corps attached to a special warfare airborne combat unit and 30 years as a law enforcement veteran. Out of the 30 years, Epi has had 24 years of narcotic, gang, and violent crimes experience. Epi has commanded and supervised numerous multi-agency task forces comprised of local, state, and federal agencies, and California (CA) DOJ special operation teams out of CA DOJ Bureau of Narcotic Enforcement (BNE) and CA DOJ Bureau of Investigation (BI).
