SYNOPSIS

Idaho Top Gun: Undercover Drug Investigation Course is a seven-day training program designed to train officers and **prosecutors** involved in undercover narcotics enforcement and prosecution on a wide range of topics related to narcotics enforcement.

The course is FREE and includes lodging and meals.

****Class size is limited to 40 students.**

Top Gun is co-hosted by the Idaho State Police, the Idaho National Guard Counter Drug program and the Oregon/Idaho HIDTA.

The course is instructed by subject matter experts from the Idaho State Police, local police agencies and State & Federal prosecutors.

Top Gun employs a mix of mediums to enhance learning. The course is built around lectures, straightforward fact-based scenarios, mini working groups, and hands-on practical applications. The course is designed to be interactive among the participants. The course is intended for officers and prosecutors currently involved in narcotics-related law enforcement. The course culminates with realistic full-contact raids on drug houses.

The course will be held at Gowen Field, and all students must stay on base throughout the training.

Students must report to the school on Sunday, September 23rd, between 1200-1400 hours, and remain at the school until noon on Saturday, September 30th. Students MUST attend the ENTIRE week of training. Students will be provided with accommodations, food, instructional materials, and the use of Gowen facilities throughout the entire week. Students will have to provide their own transportation to and from the training.

The training cycle is seven consecutive days. For planning purposes, please understand that the training day will exceed 8 hours, the exact number of hours will vary from day to day.
