Course Overview

Day 1: Time-Constrained Mission Planning

Planning Time—2 to 48 hours

Student-led teams will work through the Army's Time-constrained Leading Procedures to produce a one-page Concept of the Operation

Day 2: Deliberate Mission Planning

Planning Time—48 hours or more

Student-led teams will utilize the Army's Deliberate Decision Making Process in order to develop a multi-page Operations Order
